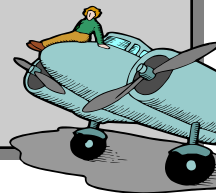

There was an FAA test in the December issue of AOPA's Flight Training magazine, page 19, that got me to thinking about how well do we know our stuff as pilots.

I selected a few of the questions that pertain to our flight area. See how you do. Of course, I provided the answers below.

- 1) An airport's rotating beacon operating during daylight hours indicates.
 - a) There are obstructions on the airport.
 - b) That weather at the airport located in Class D airspace is below basic VFR weather minimums.
 - c) The air traffic control tower is not in operation.
- 2) Pilots flying over a national wildlife refuge are requested to fly no lower than
 - a) 1,000 feet agl.
 - b) 2,000 feet agl.
 - c) 3,000 feet agl.
- 3) Which is the correct traffic pattern departure procedure to use at a nontowered airport?
 - a) Depart in any direction consistent with safety, after crossing the airport boundary.
 - b) Make all turns to the left.
 - c) Comply with any FAA traffic pattern established by the airport.

ANSWERS:

- 1) B - Ceiling is less than 1,000 feet or 3 miles visibility
- 2) B - Note, this is the minimum
- 3) B - Turns to the left unless airport displays or indicators indicate turns should be to the right

SANTA ROSA NINETY-NINES Aviation Scholarship

The Santa Rosa 99s 2011 scholarship application is now available for download.

Purpose: To provide funding to be used for a specific rating or certification to further the recipient's pursuit of a career in aviation.

Award Amount: \$3,000

Eligibility: Any women at least 17 years of age, holding at minimum a current private license, a current medical, and a current flight review. Must reside within 150 miles of Santa Rosa Airport, be eligible for the rating being applied for (i.e.: number of flight hours required, rating required, medical required), and have completed any written requirements for the rating before funds are dispersed.
