April Chapter Meeting

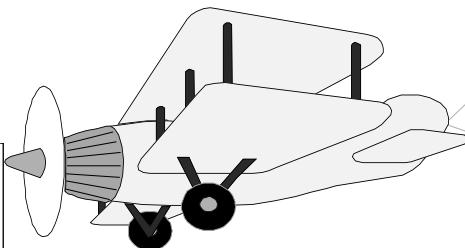
