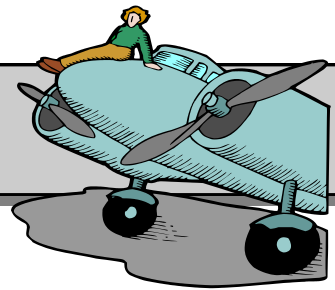

2015 Human Race Online Fundraising

- 1) Go to **www.humanracesc.org**
- 2) Select Monterey Bay Chapter Ninety Nines under **"Nonprofit Participants"** near top right
- (3) Select **"Join Team"** on side left - takes you to "Individual Sign-Up"
 - enter your information and get your link to your own personal fund-raising page
 - Login with your **username and password**
 - Manage your page (add text, photos, donation amounts) on your **Dashboard** (your login personal page)
- 5) **Send Emails** from your Dashboard or send personal emails linking your personal fund-raising page for family and friends to complete the online donation.
- 6) Donors can pay the **credit card processing fee or decline to pay it.**
- 7) **Offline donations** can be entered but that will just be an estimate. If you want to only raise funds offline, please call me and update your funds raised when you get a chance.

Turning in Offline Donations:

- (1) **Before or After Race Day:** bring money to our 99s meetings in April, May, June, July or August. You can also call me and I'll get the money from you.
- (2) **On Race Day:** don't take money to the race.....just take your pledge sheet and the race workers will take your word for it that you've raised money. They will ask you if you've raised at least \$35.
