




Ann Goldsmith, wearing the Mickey Air tee shirt gift she opened, draws the next name in the White Reindeer exchange.

And, what did Kay get? Whatever it is, it is generating great hilarity from Alice, Carolgene and Lori!



SCV 99s Whale Watching Fly-in January 8

Hi All,

Happy New Year! I hope you are finding time to fly during the (rather short) breaks in the weather. I was able to enjoy a delightful flight and dinner at Harris Ranch Xmas Eve. So, dust off your skills and get your passengers lined up for our wonderful annual whale watching flight. Here are the details:

When: Saturday Jan 8 (that's just a few days away - Yikes!)

Where: Up and down the Monterey coast - we'll meet at Zuniga's
Restaurant on the Watsonville airport for lunch at noon (you can fly before or after lunch; or both times)

What to do: Let Pat Gregory know right away if you're coming, if you have seats in your plane or if you need a ride. Get ahold of an FWPand bring her along. This is a great way to meet new 99s and friends and if you're a flight instructor this is a super training flight with lots of hold-like turns and keeping a sharp eye out for other planes, and steep turns, and talking to Norcal, etc. While you're flying, report on and monitor air-to-air frequency 122.75 to keep track of the rest of us.

Laura's Mexican Artichoke Dip

Laura Barnett brought this to our holiday potluck and many wanted the recipe. Laura says go easy on the cumin--it can be strong. She also doubled the recipe and used half chopped garlic and half Lawry's seasoning.

Makes: 2-1/2 cups dip Prep Time: 5 Minutes Cook Time: 25 Minutes

1 can (14 oz.) artichoke hearts, drained and chopped

1 cup Light Mayonnaise

1 can (4 oz.) diced green chilies, undrained

1 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese

½ cup chopped cilantro

½ tsp ground cumin and hot pepper sauce to taste.

1 clove garlic, finely chopped or (optional) and/or 1/4 tsp. Lawry's Garlic Powder with parsley

Instructions: Preheat oven to 350°. In a 1-quart casserole, combine all ingredients. Bake uncovered 25 minutes or until heated through. Serve with your favorite dippers.
