

"Second Weekends @ Watsonville" Returns in Person July 10 & 11, 2021

Tenants, Pilots and interested individuals,

We would like to thank those who participated in our Virtual Historical Aircraft Display days and encourage you to join us on July 10th and 11th as we transition back to in person Second Weekends.

In 2013 Watsonville Municipal instituted a new and innovative marketing effort to encourage our based aircraft, and pilots from surrounding airports, to not only fly more often but to do so with the following in mind: (1) purchase fuel at a reduced price, (2) if applicable take advantage of historical aircraft tax exemption and (3) obtain discounts from the airport restaurant upon presenting same day fuel receipt. We can't think of any California airport that promotes General Aviation, in such practical terms, as Watsonville Muni.

Initially the "Fuel Sale/Display Day/Restaurant Discounts" trio was scheduled for Second Saturdays only but due to popularity the airport expanded the effort to a full weekend offering the lowest self-service fuel prices within 50 nm of KWVI.

The airport's fuel sale begins on the second Saturday of each month at 0800 hours and concludes the following Monday morning at 0600 hours. The Historical Aircraft Display days begins on Saturday and continues to Sunday running from 1000 hours to 1600 hours local each day.

What's in it for you? You'll be credited with two sign-offs for July 10 and July 11.

Again, thank you for your patronage and compliance.
