SANTA ROSA NINETY-NINES Aviation Scholarship

Purpose To provide funding to be used for a specific rating or certification to further the recipient's pursuit of a career in aviation.

Award Amount \$4,000


Eligibility: Any women at least 17 years of age, holding at minimum a current private license, a current medical, and a xcurrent flight review. Must reside within 300 miles of the Charles M. Schulz Sonoma County Airport, be eligible for the rating being applied for (i.e.: number of flight hours required, medical required), and have completed anywritten requirements for the rting before funds are dispersed.

Application Due: July 1, 2022
