



31 May 1955: Test Pilot Jacqueline Marie-Thérèse Suzanne Douet Auriol flew the Dassault MD.454 Mystère IV N to a *Fédération Aéronautique Internationale* (FAI) World Record for Speed Over a 15/25 Kilometer Straight Course at Brétigny-sur-Orge, France. Her average speed of 1,151 kilometers per hour (715.198 miles per hour)—0.94 Mach—broke the previous record which had been set two years earlier by her friend, Jacqueline Cochran, by 83.32 kilometers per hour (51.773 miles per hour).



May 31, 2016—Solar Impulse lands in New York’s JFK Airport. Pilots Bertrand Piccard and Andre Borschberg shared the various legs of the flights starting from United Arab Emirates in 2015. They are circumnavigating the globe using renewable energy source to promote clean technology. 17,000 solar cells charge 5,000 pound batteries to power the plane through the night. The average speed is 33.6 knots. +It took Amelia Earhart 18 hours to fly solo from Hawaii to California. It took Piccard 62:29 hours to follow her footsteps but without fuel. +Solar Impulse landed in San Francisco on April 24th on one of its legs. +It landed in New York today and will be returning to its launch point in UAE. +You can follow its flight online. +Swiss made, top speed 50 mph, wing span 208’, weight 3,527 lbs., engine type electric.
