Other Reports and Unfinished Business:

Alice Talnack reported on SW Section meeting.

Donna update on 45th Anniversary Dinner: she has heard back from some of the past scholarship winners. Alice: we are contracted for an attendance of 60 people at \$35 each but not many people have responded. To get full return of deposit if cancelling, must cancel 30 days in advance.
