Unmanned Aircraft Systems Seminar Review

Dr. Donna Dulo was mentioned as "Brenda" and the guest speakers from the drone company were not included. Corrections are in red print and included within the relevant section of the article.

Jeanne Sabankaya and I were working the pilot registration booth at the Watsonville Fly-In on Saturday, Sept 5th. We went to the FAA Safety Seminar on unmanned aircraft systems held between two hangers during the Fly-in. It was a very interesting seminar with speakers from the FAA side and the Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) side. Karen Arendt from FAAST gave an overview of the rules that UAS's have to adhere to. She mentioned that there have been 600 incidents in the last year between manned and unmanned aircraft. I would really like to hear more about those, but we didn't have time. Dr. Donna Dulo, lawyer and UAS technical/legal researcher from the DOD/NPS spoke about the program "Know Before You Fly" and got into the rules in detail (see AC 91-57A below).

The next speakers were John Ivey from Monterey Drones and Michael Silviera from MultiRotor. To become a commercial drone pilot, you need a business license and you need to register your UAV with the FAA and get an N number. If you are taking pictures of people for profit, you need to get their permissions. He told us about a group of people playing volleyball on the beach who hired him to take a video. He had to get them all to sign permission forms.

If you plan to fly your own plane, there is plenty of parking on the airport just behind the Hiller Museum. Let Pat know your N-number and planned time of arrival.


