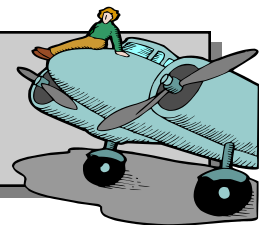

Compass Rose Tiles

Many of you are familiar with the compass rose (the official insignia of the 99s) which was painted in the center patio of HQ. The paint has deteriorated over the years, and it is being replaced with ceramic tiles as part of the building maintenance program.
