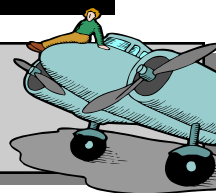

Geneva's Bavarian Cream (courtesy of Joanne Nissen)

- Soak one T gelatin and two T cold water for 5 min.
 - Stir till melted in a double boiler.
 - Add 1 or 2 cups mashed raspberries, 1 c. whipped cream and 3/4 c. powdered sugar.
 - May add 1/2 c. finely chopped nuts.
