

MB 99s International Conference Award

Purpose

The Monterey Bay Chapter of the Ninety-Nines International Organization of Women Pilots offers an annual award to chapter members and/or student pilot members to be used to attend the next scheduled International Conference. The award shall cover the conference registration cost only.

Eligibility

The applicant must be;

- A chapter member desiring to be a first time attendee to an international conference who has attended at least three (3) chapter events within the past six (6) months.

OR

- A student pilot member with a current medical, actively involved in flight training within the past 90 days prior to application, and active at chapter meetings and/or activities.

To be considered for this award the attached award application form and a personal essay must be completed.

Award applications must be received **two months** prior to the next International Conference registration deadline.

Application Guidelines

The applications will be judged on the applicant's

- Activities in and commitment to aviation
- Future plans and ambition
- Personal essay

In no more than 250 words, address the following topics;

- Your personal interest in applying for this award, aviation goals.
- How you would contribute to the Ninety-Nines and to the aviation community as a result of receiving this award.
