## January Chapter Meeting

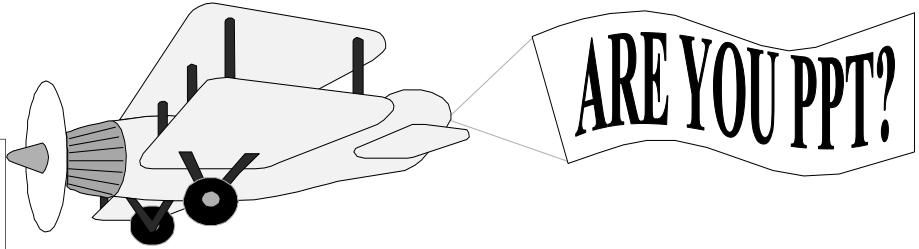

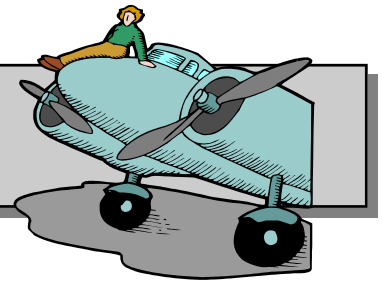

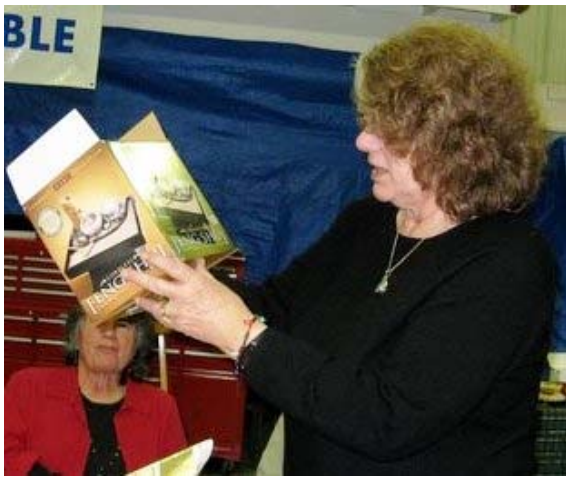
### MB99s on Display at Aptos Library
