June Chapter Meeting

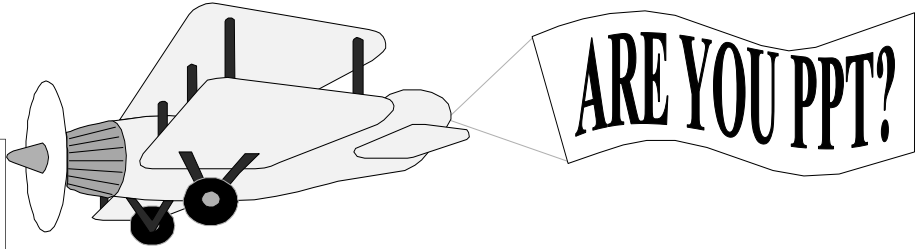

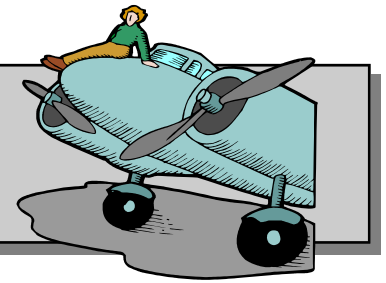

- **Six** members are attending **Spring Section** in Santa Maria, CA.
- **Three** members attended the **Winter Business Meeting**.
- **Three** of our members also attended the **Reno Air Races** and the **AOPA Convention**.
- We appeared on KSBW-TV to present **Toys for Tots** in December
- We wo"man"ed our beautiful booth at the **Watsonville Air Show** and Fly-In, handling display aircraft registration, dinner tickets, information and fun.
- We organized our annual **Dime a Pound** rides at the **Watsonville Airport Open House** and flew **160** people.
- We provided **goodies** for the airport and **Towers at WVI, SNS, and MRY**.
- We had our usual **Holiday Party and White Elephant Exchange**.
- Jody **Roberts** won our **chapter scholarship** for her **instrument rating** and also received scholarship funds from Women in Corporate Aviation.
- With almost our entire chapter participating we held our first **Flying Companion Seminar** in ten years. What made this particular FCS unique is that our **Future Women Pilots organized it**. We plan to make this a yearly event.
- We worked with **EAA Chapter 119** and provided ramp escort and safety for the **3rd Annual Day in the Sky** at WVI to provide airplane rides to **handicapped children** through the **Young Eagle's Program**.
- We walked in the **Human Race fund-raising** event for the 4th year, with at least one member dressed in a space shuttle cutout and everybody singing a song to identify us as pilots and 99s.
- Two of our members, **Donna Crane-Bailey** and **Chapter charter member Joanne Nissen**, will be inducted into the **Forest of Friendship**.
- **Geneva Cranford**, a **charter member** of our chapter, presented the **model** of our booth to the **Museum in Oklahoma City** in April 2007. This design was designated as the **official booth for The Ninety-Nines by the Board of Directors** in 1983.

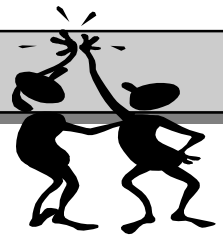

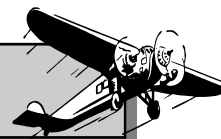
